

The Organization was established in 1993 with the headquarters located in Quebec city, Canada. Currently there are six Regional Secretariats across the world. Joined by over 300 member cities, The OWHC holds a World Congress and a Regional Conference every two years, working together for the collective development of World Heritage cities. The common goal of the OWHC member cities is to improve the preservation and management of the World Heritage sites through exchanging and sharing related knowledge and information.
